Course Description

This course is designed to provide participants with a detailed understanding of the IATA regulations specific to the safe transportation of dangerous goods, including radioactive materials. This training utilizes a systematic approach that provides a logical flow to dangerous good shipments. Study Guide scenarios are used throughout the course so participants can practice for the examination. This ensures that all necessary steps are completed to ship dangerous goods in full compliance with IATA and Department of Transportation regulations. AAHP has awarded twenty-four (24) CEUs for this class. Materials will be provided to

facilitate completing the course.

Successful participants receive a certification stating that the training meets the requirements of IATA, Section 1.5.
